

**TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT**  
Between **LENOIR-RHYNE UNIVERSITY**,  
Hereafter referred to as **LRU**, and  
**CATAWBA VALLEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE**,  
Hereafter referred to as **CVCC**

This agreement supports the transfer of students with the IT Computer Programming Associate Degree, the IT Information Systems Associate Degree, the IT Network Management Associate Degree, the IT Mobile Application Developer Associate Degree, and the IT System Security Associate Degree from CVCC into the Bachelor of Science Degree in Computer Science or the Bachelor of Arts Degree in Information Technology at LRU.

LRU agrees to accept credits for students who have completed one of the degrees listed above at CVCC. Courses and credits required for the completion of the BS degree in Computer Science or the BA degree in Information Technology at LRU are specified in the attached documents. This agreement does not apply to students transferring with a different degree, or without a degree, from CVCC or to those who choose a different major or program at LRU; such students may be evaluated for admission to LRU on a case-by-case basis.

This agreement shall commence January 31, 2020 or on the date of the last signature entered at the end of this Agreement, whichever is later, and shall terminate May 31, 2023, unless terminated earlier as provided elsewhere in this Agreement. This Agreement may be renewed by the mutual written agreement of the parties for additional terms, not to exceed five years. Either party may terminate or suspend this Agreement upon sixty days' written notice. Any student who has applied for transfer to LRU from CVCC prior to or during the sixty-day period shall be treated as if this Agreement continues in effect.

Changes made to relevant curricula at either LRU or CVCC will necessitate review of the programs at both institutions to determine if modification of the Agreement is necessary. Curriculum changes by either party must be communicated in writing no later than June 30 of any academic year.

Students shall apply for admission to LRU in accordance with rules, policies, and procedures of LRU in effect at the time of application. Students with a CVCC cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher, and with no grade below C in the major area, upon completion of their Associate's degree will be considered to have satisfied all academic requirements for admission to LRU.

As appropriate and agreed upon, courses transferred may fulfill LRU requirements. Nevertheless, students will be responsible for completing all graduation requirements of LRU in effect at the time of graduation in order to earn a bachelor's degree.

This agreement shall be reviewed annually by the parties unless significant curricular changes mandate earlier review.
